The diploma in management consultancy is a post-graduate level qualification offered by the Institute of Business Consulting (IBC), the professional body for management consultancy in the UK, and is awarded by the Chartered Management Institute (CMI).

benefits of the diploma in management consultancy

- the diploma will identify you as a qualified practitioner, providing clients with assurances that you are appropriately qualified and adhere to high professional standards
- as a recognised qualification the diploma will add value to your CV and career potential
- once registered with the Institute you will gain access to a network of fellow professionals
- material generated as part of this qualification will be counted as evidence for the certified management consultant (CMC®) award

how do I achieve the diploma in management consultancy?

face-to-face sessions

Attend nine days of training:

- internal consultancy foundation course (five-days – must be attended first)
- project management (two-days)
- communicating with impact (two-days)
- facilitation skills and workshop design (optional extra, three-days)

These courses can be attended to suit your commitments and timeframe.

consultancy portfolio

Work on your consultancy portfolio (the structure will be provided by TFC), building a document that evidences your capabilities, skills and knowledge as a management consultant. This evidence will be gathered from past and current consultancy assignment/projects over a period of 9 – 12 months.

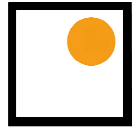
written assignment

There is one written assignment to complete that is externally set and assessed by the IBC/CMI.

exams

You will complete two open book exams over two-days at our Gatwick Airport training centre. These will be scheduled to take place according to demand.

TFC provides full support and a personal coach for the duration of the diploma to help ensure successful completion.



what is the focus of the diploma?

The qualification aims to develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours required to operate successfully as a management consultant. It focuses on the following areas:

- professional practice
- professional development
- organisation structure and culture
- entry & diagnosis
- interpersonal interaction
- group techniques
- communicating with impact
- managing consultancy interventions
- effective project management
- tools and techniques for effective consulting

pathways to getting qualified

fast track

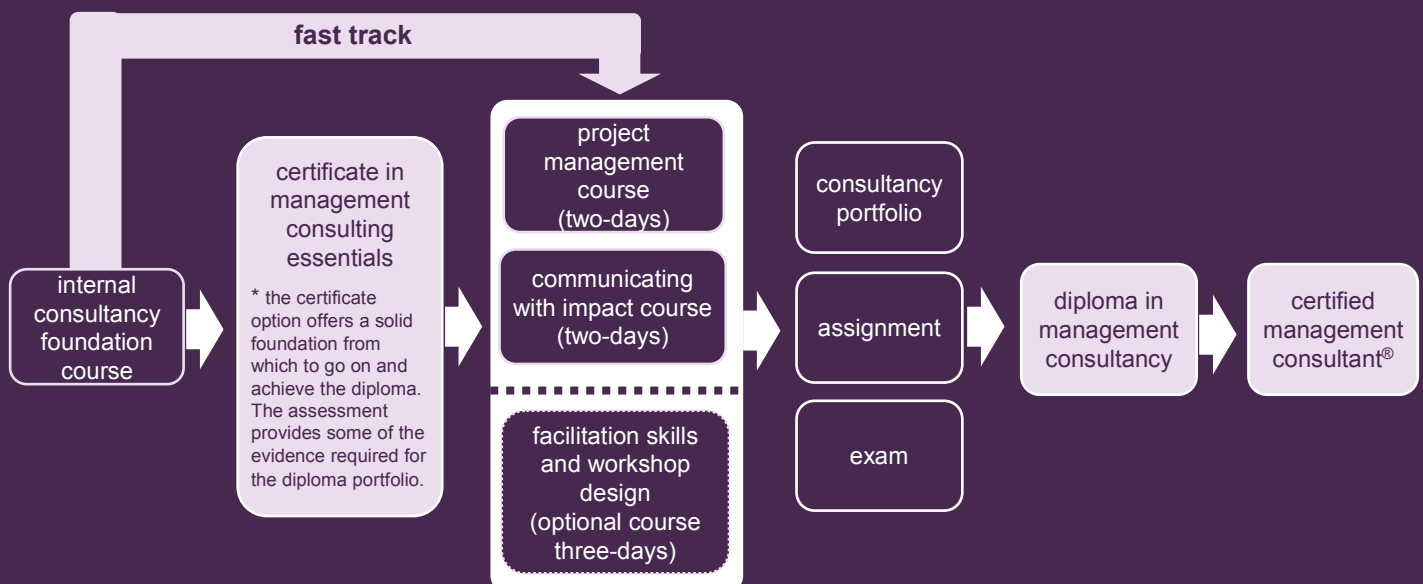
If you are a new candidate (i.e. you have not undertaken our internal consultancy foundation course or the certificate in management consulting essentials) then you can take the 'fast track' option by-passing the certificate. The total fee for this option is £4,895+VAT.

step-by-step

If you are a new candidate and wish to take a step-by-step approach you will attend our five-day internal consultancy foundation course and complete the certificate in management consulting essentials*. When you are ready to take the next step you will follow the top-up route below. The total fee for this option is £5,290+VAT (if all elements are booked in advance).

top-up

If you have already completed our five-day internal consultancy foundation course (and in some cases the certificate in management consulting essentials) all you need to do is complete two further courses (see the white box below) and undertake the diploma assessments. The total fee for this option is £2,900+VAT.
